**3) To receive information on the ongoing issues and decide further action where necessary**

**3.1 To receive a quote for a new loft ladder for the Pavilion and agree further action.**

The Clerk has obtained a quote for a new loft ladder. It was AGREED that the quote be accepted and installation arranged.

**3.2 To receive an estimate for the refurbishment of the Breary Lane Telephone box and agree further action**

The Clerk has received a second quotation for the refurbishment of the Breary Lane telephone box. It was AGREED that the second quotation represented the best value and was accepted.

**3.3 To receive an estimate for the refurbishment of The Cross**

The Clerk has received a quotation for the refurbishment of the sign at The Cross. The Clerk is pursuing a second quote for comparison.

**4) Work completed since 4<sup>th</sup> July 2017**

- Swing replaced at The Knoll
- Repairs of damaged surface at The Knoll
- Strimming of path to Hilton Grange and cut back brambles
- Fabrication of goal post hole covers
- Cut back overhanging vegetation on Leeds Road
- Removed suckers from tree at Jubilee Copse
- Cleared weeds from Well site and cut back ivy from signpost
- Washed bench at The Knoll
- Repaired broken bench at the Recreation Ground
- Secured new bench at The Birches
- Strimmed paths at The Knoll and Parklands

## **5) To receive BiB Report**

Thanks to the Clerk for contacting Billy Flynn on behalf of BiB regarding tarmacking round barrels.

Tredgold grass area - a suggestion has been made to put dwarf shrubs on the grass where cars are messing up the turf, hopefully to deter them. The landlord and shopkeepers will be contacted for their approval.

There will be bulb planting in September. Additional crocus to be planted around the Jubilee Copse sign.

### **5.1 To discuss TCV membership renewal**

It was AGREED that the TCV membership would not be renewed.

## **6) To receive Parish Council properties exception reports**

### **6.1 Puritan Chapel**

Puritan Chapel signage - a suggested location for the signage would be next to the chapel path from the A660 in the vicinity of the seat. The Clerk will pass this information to BiB who are arranging the signage. The Parish Council can supply information for the sign.

### **6.2 Memorial Garden**

#### **To receive information regarding the flag pole**

The British Legion have requested whether the Parish Council will assist with the cost of the repair of the flagpole. The Chairman requested that the Clerk ascertains ownership of the flagpole.

## **7.0 To receive Recreation Properties report**

### **7.1 The Knoll**

The Clerk has ordered some replacement parts for the climbing net as some were broken, and others on their way out. A quote is still being sought to for a repair to the net which will involve collapsing the net.

The grass cutters will return the missing bench currently at the school to The Knoll at their convenience.

### **7.2 The Recreation Ground**

A reminder has been sent to the cricket club for the 2017/18 fees to be paid. Payment remains outstanding.

## **8) Identify new jobs and agree budget**

8.1 There is an issue with the showers at the Pavilion not working. The Clerk will contact the plumber.

8.2 The Ebor Way needs strimming in the ginnel leading to Hilton Grange (Hilton Grange land). The Clerk will contact the Hilton Grange Management Company.

8.3 The hole at the entrance to the recreation ground will be refilled when the ground is dry.

- 9.1 Cllr Fox is researching the history of The Cross regarding listing.
- 9.2 The condition of the mini crosses at The Cross to be referred to FPC.
- 9.3 Cllrs Fox and Bryant and the Clerk will choose the stone for the new Bramhope signs. Cllr Harris will also be invited to attend.
